

**CITY OF JONESBORO  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
JANUARY 9th, 2012**

The City of Jonesboro Mayor and Council held their Regular Council meeting on Monday, January 9th, 2012. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Jonesboro Police Station, 170 South Main Street Jonesboro, Georgia.

Mayor Day called the meeting to order.

Prayer was given by Wayne Day. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

The Council considered approval of the Minutes from: December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Worksession, December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Called meeting, December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Public Hearing, and December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Regular meeting. Approved. [*Motion: Wiggins, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Mann, Vote: Unanimous*].

Public comments were given by Carl Helton and David Barron.

**Old Business:**

- A. Considered Rezoning request of Beatrice White-Roberts of 325 West Avenue from R4 to O&I. Approved. [*Motion: Wiggins, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Norrington, Vote: Unanimous*].

**New Business – Items B – I on agenda:**

- B. Considered Conditional Use request for Marius Pierre – 27 Lee Street to operate a convenience store currently zoned C-1. Approved. [*Motion: Compton, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Norrington, Vote: Unanimous*].
- C. Considered Mayor Pro Tem for 2012. Nomination made by Councilmember’s Mann and Norrington in favor of Councilmember Wiggins. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Compton, Vote: Yea: Compton, Mann, Norrington, Sebo, Wiggins; Nay: Segner*].
- D. Considered reappointment of City of Jonesboro employees for 2012. Approved. [*Motion: Mann, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Wiggins, Vote: Unanimous*].

- E. Considered proposed 2012 Holiday Schedule. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Compton, Vote: Unanimous*].
- F. Considered entering Executive Session for the purpose of personnel or legal matters. Approved. [*Motion: Segner, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Norrington, Vote: Unanimous*].
- G. Considered resuming Regular meeting. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Wiggins, Vote: Unanimous*].
- H. Considered vote, if any, on matters discussed in Executive Session. No vote taken.
- I. Considered motion to adjourn. Approved. [*Motion: Mann, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Norrington, Vote: Unanimous*].

Mayor Day stated that the Martin Luther King Day Parade would take place on Monday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at the downtown area parade route. Mayor Day also reminded the citizens about the monthly covered dish supper at 6:00p.m. on Thursday, January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at the Firehouse Museum and the Neighborhood Watch Meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at the Firehouse Museum.

Councilmember Wiggins suggested having the covered dish supper on the second and third Thursdays of each month. Mayor Day asked the Council for their opinion. Discussion ensued. Councilmember Segner stated that he would like it left as the second Thursday and Councilmembers Sebo, Norrington, Compton and Mann stated they would be open to either suggestions. The decision was made to keep it on the second Thursday.
