CALLED MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 26th, 2012 – 1:00 p.m.

The City of Jonesboro Mayor and Council held a Work Session on Monday, November 26th, 2012. The meeting was held at 1:00 p.m. at the Jonesboro Police Station, 170 South Main Street Jonesboro, Georgia.

Mayor Day called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

II. ITEMS: A-F

A. Discussed/considered copier printer bids. Mayor Day stated that Ms. Truhan was suggesting the Konica Minolta Bizhub 552. Mayor Day asked Ms. Truhan to address the council regarding this. The Konica Minolta Bizhub 552 has far more benefits than the other two; we would have to update those two machines which would be costly. The Konica Minolta has numerous benefits that the others do not offer. Ms. Truhan stated that we would only be purchasing paper and staples which is what we currently do now with the Konica. Mayor Day stated that for all the options that this machine offers, this one is the best for the City's needs. Ms. Truhan stated that we would be replacing the machine at City Hall and at the Police Department. Ms. Truhan stated that she provided the Council with a spreadsheet to show all the comparisons. Councilmember Sebo asked how long the City has had the ones that are currently being used. Ms. Truhan answered that we have been using these for five years. Approved. B. Discussed/considered health insurance quote through Georgia Municipal Association. Mayor Day stated that we are looking at several companies because the coverage we currently have will increase 26% next year. Mayor Day stated that the city currently pays \$26,216.00 for health insurance and \$2,212.00 for dental insurance. Mayor Day stated that if the city decides to go with GMA, the cost will be \$20,330.50 for health insurance and \$1815.00 for dental insurance. Mayor Day stated that the GMA plan offers the employee 2 choices: (1) HMO 90/10 with no deductible, (2) POS 80/60 with a \$500 deductible which allows you to go in or out of network for your doctors. Mayor Day stated it would not be a problem for our employees because

the majority of doctors in our area are in the network. Mayor Day stated that the City will be able to pay for the employees insurance and spend less than we are currently spending. We will probably stay with the same life insurance we have. GMA will come out during open enrollment to help with any employee questions to assist in making their choices. Mayor Day stated that GMA has worked very hard to get the best plans for employees. Ms. Truhan stated that the Blue Cross Blue Shield will be the same thru GMA, employees will be able to use the existing doctors they already have, the only difference would be the percentage or deductible if you choose the POS. Mayor Day stated that most doctors take BCBS and a decision needs to be made now because it would be February before the city would be able to join this plan. Mayor Day stated that plan would consist of Blue Cross Blue Shield for the health and Delta Dental. Approved. [*Motion: Wiggins, 2nd: Norrington, Vote: Unanimous*].

C. Considered Executive Session for the purpose of discussing litigation and personnel matters. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2nd: Segner, Vote: Unanimous*].

D. Discussed resuming regular meeting. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2nd: Sebo, Vote: Unanimous*].

E. Vote on matters, if any, discussed in Executive Session. No vote taken.

F. Considered motion to adjourn. Approved. [*Motion: Norrington, 2nd: Sebo, Vote: Unanimous*].
