

**CITY OF JONESBORO
WORKSESSION MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 4, 2012 – 6:00 p.m.**

The City of Jonesboro Mayor and Council held their monthly Work Session on Tuesday, September 4th, 2012. The meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. at the Jonesboro Police Station, 170 South Main Street Jonesboro, Georgia.

Mayor Day called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

WORKSESSION ITEMS:

- Discussed annexation of the property at 9140 Turner Road – property owner Foresta H. Neace – application for annexation. Mayor Day stated that she had issued a copy of the letter that was sent to Clayton County required by law and the City is following all the guidelines that are necessary. Mayor Day advised the council that a small part of the property is in the city limits and we were approached by the property owner. Councilmember Wiggins asked if there had been any response from the county. Mayor Day replied that there has not been any response from them. Councilmember Wiggins asked how far down the property extends. Mayor Day stated that she has a plat of the property and will give a copy to all the council members. Councilmember Wiggins stressed his concern over tractor trailers coming through the city. Mayor Day stated that the city has an ordinance regarding this issue and it will override and problems that could occur, but she does not foresee any. Mayor Day added that Tara Wrecker has always followed the approved driving route in the city.

Mayor Day asked if there were any other questions or comments. Mayor Day stated that the plans and specs for Fayetteville Road sidewalk project are ready and will be opened at 11:00am on October 2nd, 2012 in the main courtroom at 170 S. Main St.

Mayor Day stated that classes are being offered by the Police Department and read the list for the public. Mayor Day stated that the work on Streetscape Phase II continues, but we have documents that need to be re-done and we are working on them. We have met with the utility companies and are looking at 90 days to start. Mayor Day expressed concern regarding the banner arms that are on the street light poles and stated that the City Engineer, Tommy Newsome is working on the issue.

Mayor Day adjourned the meeting.
