

**CITY OF JONESBORO
WORKSESSION MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 9TH, 2013 – 6:00 p.m.**

The City of Jonesboro Mayor and Council held a Worksession on Monday, September 9th, 2013. The meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. at the Jonesboro Police Station, 170 South Main Street Jonesboro, Georgia.

Mayor Pro Tem Sebo called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

WORKSESSION ITEMS:

Discussed Carriage Lane – street and storm drain improvement bids. Councilmember Mann discussed an issue that he has with the bids where he thinks some items are priced too high. Councilmember Segner raised questions as to why the project was sent back for re-bidding. Ms. Truhan explained that because no one was confirmed during the first process it had to be placed for re-bidding and there is no rule stating that the same companies are not eligible to bid again. Ms. Truhan explained that the City has to follow regulated guidelines.

Public Comments – None.

Discussed North Avenue – sidewalk improvement bids. Mayor Pro Tem Sebo asked if there was any discussion for improving the sidewalks on North Avenue from Fayetteville Road to Main Street. Mayor Pro Tem Sebo suggested that we put this on the list when we look at another phase for this project.

Public Comments – Mr. Barron questioned the exact location for the improvements.

Discussed proposed 1.5 Millage rate. Councilmember Segner asked Ms. Meyers about the revenue status of the City as this would help in his decision on the need for taxes. Councilmember Segner also questioned Ms. Meyers regarding the revenue from the tag readers.
