COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 12, 2007**

The City of Jonesboro Mayor and Council held their monthly council meeting on Monday, March 12, 2007. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Jonesboro Police Station, 170 South Main Street , Jonesboro , Georgia .

- Considered the Variance Request - Steve C. Bullard, owner, #236 & #238 Stockbridge Road , tabled. [*Motion to table: Maddox, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Wenz, Vote: Unanimous*]. Steve Bullard to supply plans showing set backs and buffers. Will submit new request after review.

- Considered the business license request for the Home Occupation â€ Motivational Pearls, owner Charlene Mc Cracken, C.E.O., approved. [*Motion: Wenz, 2nd: Yonce, Vote: Unanimous*].
