H. - Considered motion to adopt amendments to Environmental Ordinance. Approved. [*Motion: Grider, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Mann, Vote: Unanimous*].

I. – Considered motion to adopt amendments to Nuisance Ordinance. Approved . [*Motion: Grider, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Mann, Vote: Unanimous*].
